

Pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, M.G.L. c. 66, § 10, the law only applies to records. The law does not require a government entity to answer specific questions or to create records in response to a public records request. Therefore, to the extent that the above requests seek specific information to be provided in a specific manner, please note that no new records will be created in response to your request. Any existing records that are determined to be within the District's possession, custody or control and that are responsive to your request will be provided.

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 66, this serves as the District's response to your request.

After conducting a search, the District has determined that seven (7) pages of records exist within the possession, custody or control of the District that are responsive to your request and are provided in the attachments to this response. The attached record represents "Part One of Two Part Agreement" as indicated in the title of the agreement. Part Two has not yet been executed, therefore cannot be released as a public record.

I am happy to further assist you in identifying additional records you are seeking.

Pursuant to 950 CMR 32.08(1) and M.G.L. c. 66, §10(b), you have the right to appeal or seek redress of any denial of your public records request insofar as it pertains to the exceptions cited in this letter through an administrative process provided by the Supervisor of Public Records, within the Division of Public Records of the Office of the Secretary of State for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
